New Minibus Service: Weekly trip to Ripon now picks up in Darley!

Nidderdale Plus has now been running a market service to Ripon and Skipton since June, when we took delivery of our new minibus.

After the meeting of our first service user group we have now changed the service to a weekly trip to Ripon on Thursday each week which will start in Pateley Bridge then pick up in villages down the dale at local bus stops, stopping in: Glasshouses, Low Laithe, Summerbridge, Dacre Banks, Dacre Top, Darley, Birstwith and Shaw Mills before continuing to Ripon.

The service will start from Pateley at 10.15 am (TBC) and leave from Ripon at 2.30 pm (TBC). We will be posting schedules on bus stops as soon as the service is finalised in late September, **BUT PRE-BOOKING IS ESSENTIAL**, owing to limited spaces on the bus. We can confirm pick up time from Darley when you call to book.

The return fare to Ripon is £8. You need to call 714953 to book a place on the service, and payment can be made over the phone by card, or on the day of travel by either card or cash.

<u>GROUP HIRE</u>. The minibus is also available for group hire by not-for-profit groups, charities and schools, etc, and we can supply a driver. Call 714953 to find out more and get a quote.

Darley & Menwith Parish Council

The next three Parish Council meetings are scheduled to take place on Monday 26 September, Monday 31 October and Monday 28 November, all in the meeting room at Darley Memorial Hall, Sheepcote Lane, Darley. The September meeting starts at 8pm but later meetings may revert to the earlier start time of 7.30pm. The agenda for all meetings is published on the three Parish Council noticeboards and the website (www.darleyvillage.info) six days before the meeting. Parishioners are welcome to attend and there is an opportunity for parishioners to speak at meetings on any matter over which the Council has a power.

The Parish Council would like to echo the recent request from North Yorkshire County Council for parishioners to cut back any hedges or trees on their property that could be putting pedestrians and road users at risk. In particular, hedges and trees which obstruct pavements can make it difficult for pedestrians to pass, forcing them onto verges and roads.

Harrogate Borough Councillor Tom Watson is helping with a small number of teething problems following the installation of the new larger bins throughout the Parish. The new bins are designed to be emptied as part of the regular Waste & Recycling collections. The Parish Council asks that these waste bins are not used for domestic waste and recycling as this can cause bins to overflow and prevent people from disposing of dog waste and litter safely.

The WI can be anything and everything you want it to be - A WI membership can offer you an opportunity to meet new people in your local area, catch up with friends, have fun and learn new things.


